

Fire Department Police & Fire Commission Report

June 28th thru September 5th, 2017

The department responded to 530 incidents during this 70 day reporting period, which included; 6 fire calls, 257 Local EMS calls, 4 Motor-Vehicle Accidents with injuries, 8 Motor-Vehicle Accidents without injuries, 93 Advanced-Life-Support intercepts, 53 Township EMS calls, 112 Interfacility transfers (23 Critical Care), 10 Hazardous Condition calls (natural gas leaks, chemical spills, carbon monoxide alarm activation, downed power lines...), 9 fire alarm activations, 4 service related requests (Lock-outs, assist other agencies), and 1 Water Rescue.










Community Events
